

Attendees

The 2020 EIPBN commercial session runs from Tuesday, May 26, to Thursday, May 29, 2020. EIPBN attendees are the top engineers and scientists in the 3-Beams and nanotechnologies. The commercial session provides an outstanding opportunity to meet and interact with scientist and engineers in fields ranging from nanoelectronics to biological and chemical sciences. The average annual attendance since 2010 is 415. Attendees come from over 20 countries around the world. The conference typically includes 71% from North America, 15% from Europe, 12% from Asia, and the remaining 2% from other countries. 46% of our attendees are from universities, 41% are from industry, and 12% are from government labs.



Academic Government Industry Brief History

- 1959: The 3-Beams conference origins trace back over five decades to a 1959 meeting in Boston. While the early meetings focused on using electron beam materials processing like e-beam melting, cutting and welding, the focus shifted with the explosive growth of the IC industry.
- 1965: The IC industry, to keep pace with Gordon Moore's 1965 observation, created a demand for the art and science of controlling beams.
- 1970: By the 14th meeting, one quarter of the conference was dedicated to electron and ion beams in microelectronics. The mastery of focusing and controlling beams of energy to generate arbitrary patterns was the key breakthrough needed to transfer increasingly massive amounts of information into the digital circuits which we enjoy today.
- Today: 3-Beams now features three full days of presentations, posters, and discussions. It commences with a plenary session followed by three parallel sessions, and includes a thriving interactive commercial session that has helped connect buyers and sellers for 25 years. The conference proceedings are published in the prestigious Journal of Vacuum Science and Technology.



Commercial Session

The commercial session is an excellent opportunity to reconnect with existing customers, generate new leads, and interact with leading

experts from industry, academia, and government laboratories, while promoting new business and alliances.

All exhibitors will have their logos displayed on the website, at the conference, and on the back cover of the program guide. Exhibitors will be given an opportunity to give an oral presentation about their company during the commercial session. To help promote foot traffic, attendees can participate in a raffle for visiting all the booths. The winner will be announced at the Banquet. The Conference Chair will also host a "Thank You" reception for exhibitors and sponsors.

Corporate sponsorships play an important role in the continued success of the conference and help support our technical community in a variety of ways including supporting student attendees with travel expenses, sponsoring events like the Women In Nanofabrication (WIN) luncheon, the Student Breakfast, and the Student Mentor Lunch.

EIPBN also tries each year to give back to the local community by organizing an outreach event. Exhibitors and sponsors are welcome to attend and/or sponsor this event. See the Commercial Session Chair for details about this years event.

Being a sponsor is a great way to put your business front and center. In many cases, sponsors are encouraged to work with the conference coordinator on branding and other promotional opportunites that can increase visibility and interaction with attendees.

Three support levels are available to help drive traffic to your booth and increase interactions with the attendees. The support levels are determined by the total contribution to sponsorships that include breakfasts, coffee breaks, and lunches, as well as purchases like booths, banquet tickets, full conference exhibitor/technical passes. Priority for booth selection and speaking time/date is determined by support level and registration date.

Platinum is the top support level. Companies with a total contribution to registration, sponsorships and other purchases that exceeds \$18k before April 1, 2020, or \$20k thereafter will be recognized as Platinum Sponsors. Platinum Sponsors are allowed two slides to be shown during session intermissions that showcase their company, including sponsorship level, and to announce exclusive offerings. They can request up to 4 courtesy Banquet tickets, 4 Thank You reception tickets, and 20 additional drink tickets to distribute at their discretion. The EIPBN 2020 commercial session program features:

Gold is the second highest support level. Companies with a total contribution to registration, sponsorships and other purchases that exceeds \$10k before April 1, 2020 or \$12k thereafter will be recognized as gold sponsors. Gold sponsors are allowed one slide to showcase their company during session intermissions. They can request up to 2 courtesy Banquet tickets, 4 Thank You reception tickets, and 14 additional drink tickets to distribute at their discretion.

Silver is the third highest support level. Companies with a total contribution to registration, sponsorships and other purchases that exceeds \$8k before April 1, 2020, or \$10k thereafter will be recognized as silver sponsors. Silver sponsors will have their company logo prominently displayed with other silver sponsors during session intermissions. They can request up to 4 Thank You reception tickets, and 8 additional drink tickets to distribute at their discretion.



Marketing Driven Sponsorship

Connecting with existing customers and creating new ones is the primary reason for exhibiting at EIPBN. Our unique environment will increase your organization's visibility and exposure to our community and help build new relationships that will

last. To this end, incentives encourage attendees to visit the exhibits and attend the oral presentations. To help draw attendees to your booth, each exhibitor will be given drink drink tickets to distribute at their discretion. In many cases, sponsorships are designed to help drive attendees to your booth and increase your companies profile. Event sponsors are welcomed to work with the conference coordinator on branding and other promotional opportunities that can increase visibility and interaction with attendees.

Sponsorships fall into 5 categories:

Outreach includes co-sponsoring activities like the Women in Nanofabrication (WIN) Lunch, The Student Breakfast and the Student Mentor Lunch. Sponsors will be acknowledged at the beginning of the lunch.

Meals include conference breakfasts and lunches. Sponsored meals will be advertised with the sponsor prominently identified. In particular, the Wednesday Lunch will have the service tables in the exhibition hall.

Session Breaks include coffee and ice cream breaks. Co-sponsored session breaks will be held exclusively in the commercial session area. When possible, the coffee and/or ice cream snack tables will be placed in the vicinity of the sponsor's booth. **Drinks** include sponsorships for the Welcome Reception, Poster Session and Banquet bars. Sponsorships for these bars will include 10 additional drink tickets for the sponsor to pass out at their discretion.

Exclusive Branding will be available again this year for folios, conference bags, banner/lanyards, logo on hotel room keys, hotel room key log and USB keys. Exclusive branding increases both visibility and brand recognition.
